#### KEYNOTE SPEAKER ANDREA N. HUNT, PH.D.



Andrea N. Hunt is an Associate Professor of Sociology, Director of the Mitchell-West Center for Social Inclusion, and Special Assistant to the Vice President for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion at the University of North Alabama. She is a proud firstgeneration graduate and earned her bachelor's degree at Rogers State University before attending the University of South Alabama and later NC State University for her graduate studies. Her teaching, research, and community work cover a range of interrelated topics including trauma, identity, inequality, career development, mentoring, and inclusive practices. Dr. Hunt has facilitated numerous workshops on creating more inclusive environments in education, nonprofits, and organizations; academic advising for diverse student populations; preparing high school students for college; best practices for online learning; and techniques for teaching about social inequality. Dr. Hunt is a court appointed special advocate, and on the Board of Directors for OnePlace of the Shoals and Riverbend Center for Mental Health. She works in the community with mental health professionals, social workers, youth in juvenile detention, and adults in recovery. She is currently pursuing a degree in counseling to better support her community. She was recently awarded the George Merida Huckaba Endowed Professorship for 2020-2021 and the W.T. McElheny Award from UNA's Student Government Association for her advocacy. She is the recipient of UNA's College of Arts and Sciences Early Career Service Award, UNA's College of Arts and Sciences Early Career Teaching Award, UNA's Academic Affairs Outstanding Service Award, UNA's Housing and Residence Life award for Faculty Collaborator of the Year, UNA's College of Arts and Sciences Outstanding Faculty Award, and UNA's President's Diversity Award. She has served as the awards Chair for SWS-S and the Chair of the Lyman Book Award Committee for the Mid-South Sociological Association. She is currently the Chair for the Committee on the Profession for the Mid-South Sociological Association and Chair for the Committee on Sociological Practice for the Southern Sociological Society.
